A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4166 AS INTRODUCED 2-14-89

The bill would adopt English as the official state language and provide that the state could not require official documents to use any language other than English. However, state policies, documents, and so forth could require educational instruction in a language other than English for the purpose of making students using a language other than English proficient in English.
