A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4169 AS INTRODUCED 2-14-89

The Circuit Court Family Counseling Services Act provides for, but does not require, the establishment of family counseling services in each judicial circuit. The bill would require the state court administrator's office to survey implementation of the act since 1980 (the act was created in 1964 and amended in 1980 to revise funding provisions). Within six months after the bill took effect, the office would have to provide to the legislature a detailed report as prescribed by the bill. The court administrator would have to make recommendations for legislative, administrative, or funding changes in the program.
