A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4170, - 4173 AS INTRODUCED 2-14-89

The bills would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to allow certain veterans or members of the Michigan National Guard to get one or more specially inscribed license plates for a five dollar service fee. The initial application would have to be accompanied by any proof required by the secretary of state that the applicant was a veteran or national guard member, and handicapped veterans or national guard members could get a handicapper tab and the special plate for the five dollar fee. Use of the special plate by someone who did not qualify for it or on a vehicle other than that for which the plate was issued would be a misdemeanor.

The bills would allow the following people to apply for specially inscribed plates:

House Bill 4170: World War II veterans (special identification numbers preceded by "WWII" and the words "WORLD WAR II VETERAN" under the registration number)

House Bill 4171: Korean War veterans (special identification number and "KOREAN WAR VETERAN" under the registration number)

House Bill 4172: Vietnam veterans (special identification number and "VIETNAM VETERAN" under the registration number)

House Bill 4173: Michigan National Guard members (special identification number and "NATIONAL GUARD MEMBER" under the registration number)
