A SUMMARY OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION D & HOUSE BILL 4207 AS INTRODUCED 2-16-89

House Joint Resolution D would amend Article VI Section 19 of the state constitution to delete the prohibition against a person being elected or appointed to judicial office after reaching the age of 70 years. The resolution would be submitted to the voters at the next general election.

House Bill 4207 would amend the Judges' Retirement Act to eliminate various provisions that bar membership in the retirement system and the accumulation of service credit after the term in which the member attained age 70.
