A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4209 AS INTRODUCED 2-16-89

The bill would amend the Department of Corrections act to require parole eligibity reports to include certain information on prisoners who had tested positive for the AIDS virus, or any other sexually transmitted disease. The information would be used by the parole board, when considering a grant of parole, in deciding them whether a prisoner had voluntarily contacted each person he or she might have exposed to the virus, and whether the contacts had been notified as to their risk of exposure and possible infection.
