A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4314 and 4315 AS INTRODUCED 2-28-89

House Bills 4314 and 4315 would amend the Older Michiganians Act and the Mental Health Code, respectively, to require the Office of Services to the Aging and the Department of Mental Health to cooperate on a study of the emerging long-term health care needs of developmentally disabled persons over the age of fifty that would recommend a plan for providing information and access to appropriate health care services. The bills would require that a report on the study be completed, and a copy provided to the legislature, not later than one year after the bills took effect.

The bills are tie-barred to each other.
