A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4390 AS INTRODUCED 3-7-89

Currently, the daily limit for perch is 50 in the Upper Peninsula and other waters of the state and 100 in Lake Huron south of the Mackinac Bridge, in the St. Clair River, Lake St. Clair, the Detroit River, and in Lake Erie. The bill would amend the Michigan Sportsmen Fishing Law to impose a daily limit of 50 perch in the Upper Peninsula and in Great Lakes waters within ten miles of a border of the Upper Peninsula and a 100 perch limit in all other waters of the state.
