A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4431 AS INTRODUCED 3-14-89

Currently, under the Michigan Conservation Corps Act, corpsmembers may not be employed for more than one year. The bill would amend the act to permit the Department of Natural Resources to employ up to one-third of the corps' supervisors for not more than three years, and to increase the supervisory wage from \$5.50 to \$6.50 per hour. Further, the bill would repeal the act's December 31, 1987 expiration date.
