A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4541 AS INTRODUCED 3-14-89

The School Code prohibits an intermediate school (ISD) board from expending budgeted area vocational-technical education funds (raised through annual property tax levies) for purposes other than those set forth in the act, such as for operating state board-approved vocational-technical education and programs, acquiring land, buildings and equipment. The bill would amend the act to permit an ISD board to use the funds received through the levying of taxes specifically to pay for costs related to holding a special election to renew or increase the millage limit on annual property tax levied for area vocational-technical education purposes.
