**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4613 AS INTRODUCED 4-12-89**

The bill would create within the Department of Commerce a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Fund. The fund would receive community development block grant revenue received under the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, along with certain other federally-derived revenues, plus gifts and other sources of revenue designated for the fund.

The fund could be used only for the rehabilitation of property as set forth in the federal act. At least 35 percent of the money disbursed from the fund each fiscal year would be allocated to the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) to assist activities related to housing and described by portions of the federal law.
