A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4652 AS INTRODUCED 4-13-89

The bill would create a new act that would require all video reproductions of motion picture films to conspicuously display the official rating of the Motion Picture Association of America. Videos of movies that had not been given an official rating or of movies that had been altered after receiving an official rating would be exempt from this requirement. Anyone violating the act would be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$100.
