A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4693 AS INTRODUCED 4-24-89

Under the Michigan Vehicle Code, dealers of vehicles required to be titled are required to apply for a new title within fifteen days after delivering a vehicle to a purchaser and are required to transfer or secure registration plates and a certificate of registration for the vehicle in the name of the purchaser. The bill would amend the code to include under the requirement persons engaged in the sale of vessels required to be numbered by the Marine Safety Act who were delivering boat trailers weighing less than 2,500 pounds to a purchaser. The bill would also allow these persons to be issued temporary registration plates or markers for use by purchasers of boat trailers weighing less than 2,500 pounds. The bill would require the secretary of state's office to designate the form to be used in the case of temporary registration plates or markers used for boat trailers.
