A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4705 AS INTRODUCED 4-26-89

Public Act 210 of 1945, the act governing county jail rules and regulations, permits county sheriffs to credit a prisoner with a good behavior allowance that reduces the prisoner's jail sentence. Under the bill, the sheriff, in addition, could reduce the sentence of a prisoner who worked as a trusty by one day for each ten days the prisoner worked, up to a maximum of three days per month.
