A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4706 AS INTRODUCED 4-26-89

Violation of Public Act 166 of 1965, which regulates prevailing wages on state projects, is considered a misdemeanor. The bill would amend the act to provide, in addition, that a contractor who violated the act would be prohibited from bidding on state projects for two years after the date of conviction, and would be required to pay to each construction mechanic the difference between the prevailing wage in the locality of the state project and the actual wages paid.
