A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4883 AS INTRODUCED 6-1-89

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to require that a person imprisoned in a county jail as a condition of probation serve his or her term of imprisonment in one consecutive period, rather than in nonconsecutive intervals, if the offense for which the person was convicted was an assaultive crime, or a crime involving drugs.
