A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4964 AS INTRODUCED 7-12-89

The Michigan Vehicle Code requires a driver of a vehicle who believes he or she was involved in an accident resulting in a serious or aggravated injury to or a death to stay at the accident scene in order to identify himself or herself and to help anyone injured in the accident. A person who fails to stop and give aid is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment up to 2 years or a \$2,000 fine, or both. The bill would increase the penalty to imprisonment for up to 5 years or a fine of up to \$5,000, or both.
