A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5195 AS INTRODUCED 10-18-89

The bill would amend the Michigan Election Law so that a county board of commissioners would appoint members to a township board if one or more vacancies had reduced the number of people serving to less than the minimum number required to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The commissioners would appoint the number needed for a quorum. A person appointed in this manner would hold the office for the remainder of the unexpired term.
