A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 5256 & 5257 AS INTRODUCED 11-1-89

House Bills 5256 and 5257 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code (MCL 257.676a) and Public Act 205 of 1941 (MCL 252.52), which regulates the construction and use of limited access highways, respectively, to permit a person who obtained approval by the Department of Transportation to operate a commercial enterprise for the selling, or displaying for sale, of goods, wares, produce, fruit, vegetables, or other merchandise. Under House Bill 5257, written approval could be granted to a commercial enterprise to operate on limited access highway property after the department had determined the operation did not violate applicable federal laws.
