A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5291 AS INTRODUCED 11-15-89

The Vehicle Code limits the use of strobe lights (a white, intermittent flashing light) on school buses to certain situations, including inclement weather conditions, such as in fog, or in certain driving situations, such as when students are being picked up or dropped off. The bill would amend the act to add that strobe lights could be used by a school bus driver at anytime between the hours of sunset and sunrise.
