SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 55 as introduced 1-31-89:

The bill would amend the Michigan Law Enforcement Officers Training Council Act to increase membership on the Council from 11 to 15 and specify that the additional members would be appointed by the Governor from lists of names (three names on each list) submitted by the Police Officers Association of Michigan, the Michigan Association of Police, Women Police of Michigan, Inc., and the Wayne County Association of Chiefs of Police.

FISCAL IMPACT

According to the Michigan Law Enforcement Officers Training Council, total annual reimbursement costs for members traveling to meetings average \$6,500. This is based on an eleven-member committee from which 10 usually are in attendance at Council meetings. Annual reimbursement costs per member, therefore, are approximately \$650. Adding four additional members could represent an increase in cost of \$2,600 annually.
