SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 280 as introduced 4-5-89:

The bill would amend the Revised Probate Code to exempt a claim for compensation for services rendered, and for reimbursement of expenses, from the requirement that a personal representative give a copy of a claim against a decedent's estate to all interested parties within seven days after the time for original presentation of the claim has expired.
