SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 436 as introduced 5-9-89:

The bill would amend the Nonprofit Health Care Corporation Reform Act to specify that the supplemental Medicare benefits certificates that corporations are required to offer to nongroup applicants need not cover out patient prescription drug deductibles, and to require corporations offering Medicare supplemental certificates to comply with the provisions in the Federal Social Security Act concerning voluntary certification of Medicare supplemental insurance policies, receipt of claims from participating physicians and suppliers and assignment of benefits.
