SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 458 as enrolled:

The bill would amend the General Property Tax Act to require that the amount of taxes that were to be levied for the continuation of drug enforcement in a county, for police protection, or for road improvements in a township, that were approved at an election on November 8, 1988, would be certified for the 1988 calendar year.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the State. The bill would allow for the initial levy in 1988 rather than 1989 of millage approved by the local voters on November 8, 1988.
