SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 482 as introduced 5-31-89:

The bill would amend Public Act 156 of 1851, which defines the powers and duties of county boards of commissioners, to allow a county board of commissioners, by resolution, to submit to the voters for an advisory vote any action that the board had the authority to take. The resolution would have to specify the date of the election, which could be either a general or special election.
