AN ACT to provide for the conveyance of the state's interest in certain property located in the county of Dickinson; and to provide for disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the state, may convey to the township school district of the township of Breitung, for fair market value, any interest held by the state in certain property located in the city of Kingsford, county of Dickinson, and more particularly described as follows:

Lots Seven (7), Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) of Block Eight (8) of the Plat of Skidmore's Addition. Lot Eighteen (18) of Block Five (5) of the Plat of Garden Village.

- Sec. 2. The documents required in the conveyance authorized by this act shall be approved by the attorney general.
- Sec. 3. The revenue received under this act shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
