 (2) A township board may appoint not more than 2 alternate

The alternate member may be called as specified in the zoning ordinance to sit as regular members of the zoning board of appeals in the absence of a regular member if a regular member is absent from or unable to attend 2 or more consecutive meetings of the zoning board of appeals or for a period of more than 30 consecutive days. An alternate member may also be called to serve in the place of a regular member for the purpose of reaching a decision on a case in which the regular member has abstained for reasons of conflict of interest.
