## **HOUSE BILL No. 5408**

January 24, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Sofio, Stupak, Alley, DeMars, Hickner, Gagliardi, Niederstadt, Sikkema, Stacey, Crandall, Ouwinga, Joe Young, Jr., Pitoniak, Weeks, Murphy, Spaniola and Camp and referred to the Committee on Forestry and Minerals.

A bill to amend sections 2101, 2103, 2105, 2107, and 2108 of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled "Occupational code,"

section 2103 as amended by Act No. 83 of the Public Acts of 1981 and section 2107 as amended by Act No. 463 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections 339.2101, 339.2103, 339.2105, 339.2107, and 339.2108 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add sections 2109, 2111, and 2113.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 2101, 2103, 2105, 2107, and 2108 of Act
- 2 No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, section 2103 as amended by
- 3 Act No. 83 of the Public Acts of 1981 and section 2107 as amended
- 4 by Act No. 463 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections

- 1 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended and sections 2109, 2111, and
- 2 2113 are added to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 2101. As used in this article:
- 4 (a) "Forester" means a person AN INDIVIDUAL who by
- 5 reason of his or her knowledge of the natural sciences, mathemat-
- 6 ics, and the principles of forestry, acquired by forestry educa-
- 7 tion and practical experience, is qualified ENGAGES IN OR OFFERS
- 8 to engage in the practice of professional forestry.
- 9 (b) "Practice of professional forestry" means -professional
- 10 forestry services, including consultation, investigation, evalu-
- 11 ation, planning, or responsible supervision of forestry interns
- 12 or forest technicians when the professional service requires the
- 13 application of forestry principles and techniques PERFORMING OR
- 14 OFFERING TO PERFORM SERVICES WHICH REQUIRE A KNOWLEDGE OF THE
- 15 NATURAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS, AND THE PRINCIPLES AND TECHNIQUES
- 16 OF FORESTRY ACQUIRED BY FORESTRY EDUCATION AND PRACTICAL
- 17 EXPERIENCE, WHICH SERVICES INCLUDE CONSULTATION, INVESTIGATION,
- 18 EVALUATION, PLANNING, OR SUPERVISION OF FORESTRY ACTIVITIES. THE
- 19 PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (i) THE INVESTIGATION OF THE ECOLOGY OF FORESTLAND SOILS,
- 21 PLANTS, AND ANIMALS.
- 22 (ii) THE APPLICATION OF SCIENTIFIC KNOWLEDGE IN THE FIELDS
- 23 OF URBAN TREE GROWTH AND MANAGEMENT, FORESTLAND MANAGEMENT AND
- 24 PROTECTION, TIMBER GROWING AND UTILIZATION, FOREST RESOURCE
- 25 INVENTORIES, WATERSHED MANAGEMENT, FOREST ECONOMICS AND FINANCE,
- 26 TIMBER APPRAISAL, AIR AND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ON FORESTLANDS,
- 27 OUTDOOR RECREATION, AND THE MANAGEMENT OF FORESTLAND SCENERY.

- 1 (iii) THE MARKING OF CUTTING OR TREATMENT LINES BETWEEN
- 2 PROPERTY CORNERS IN ORDER TO OUTLINE UPON THE GROUND PREMISES FOR
- 3 FORESTRY ACTIVITY.
- 4 (iv) THE PRESCRIBING OF FOREST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES CONSIS-
- 5 TENT WITH STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS.
- 6 (C) "TIMBER" MEANS TREES, STANDING OR FELLED, WHICH ARE
- 7 CAPABLE OF BEING UTILIZED FOR BUILDING, STRUCTURAL, MANUFACTUR-
- 8 ING, PROCESSING, OR ENERGY PRODUCTION PURPOSES.
- 9 Sec. 2103. (1) A person shall receive a certificate of
- 10 registration as a forester if the person graduates from an
- 11 accredited university or college, has 2 or more years of
- 12 experience in forestry work, and is of good moral character. THE
- 13 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE AS A FORESTER TO AN INDIVIDUAL
- 14 WHO MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (A) IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.
- 16 (B) IS OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER.
- 17 (C) HAS PROVIDED PROOF OF COMPLETION OF AT LEAST A BACCALAU-
- 18 REATE DEGREE FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY AND A FOR-
- 19 ESTRY CURRICULUM ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD.
- 20 (D) HAS PROVIDED DOCUMENTATION OF THE EQUIVALENT OF AT LEAST
- 21 2 YEARS OF FULL-TIME EXPERIENCE IN THE PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL
- 22 FORESTRY ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD, COMPLETED UNDER THE SUPERVISION
- 23 OF A REGISTERED OR LICENSED FORESTER.
- 24 (2) A LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE ISSUED ONLY TO AN
- 25 INDIVIDUAL AND NOT TO A FIRM, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
- 26 CO-PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.

- 1 Sec. 2105. A plan, map, specification, or report issued by
- 2 a registered forester LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE shall be
- 3 indorsed with his or her name and -certificate of registration-
- 4 LICENSE number during the life of the certificate of
- 5 registration LICENSE. A registered forester LICENSED UNDER
- 6 THIS ARTICLE shall not indorse a plan, specification, estimate,
- 7 or map unless the registered forester LICENSEE actually pre-
- 8 pared the plan, specification, estimate, or map or was in the
- 9 actual charge of the preparation of the plan, specification,
- 10 estimate, or map.
- 11 Sec. 2107. The department shall <del>register</del> ISSUE A LICENSE
- 12 TO an applicant who is a legally -authorized REGULATED forester
- 13 in another state or country if the requirements of the state or
- 14 country are considered by the board to be equivalent to the
- 15 requirements of <del>registration</del> LICENSURE in this state.
- 16 Sec. 2108. (1) A person shall not use the title
- 17 "registered forester" unless he or she is registered under this
- 18 article ENGAGE IN OR OFFER TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF PROFES-
- 19 SIONAL FORESTRY IN THIS STATE WITHOUT BEING LICENSED OR EXEMPT
- 20 FROM LICENSURE UNDER THIS ARTICLE.
- 21 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT USE OR IMPLY THE USE OF ANY OF THE
- 22 FOLLOWING TITLES OR ANY TITLE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THOSE
- 23 LISTED WITHOUT BEING LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE: "FORESTER",
- 24 "LICENSED FORESTER", "REGISTERED FORESTER", "REGISTERED PROFES-
- 25 SIONAL FORESTER", "PROFESSIONAL FORESTER", OR "LICENSED PROFES-
- 26 SIONAL FORESTER".

- 1 (3) A PERSON SHALL NOT ADVERTISE THAT A FIRM, PARTNERSHIP,
- 2 CORPORATION, CO-PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY
- 3 OFFERS PROFESSIONAL SERVICES REGULATED BY THIS ARTICLE UNLESS AN
- 4 INDIVIDUAL LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE IS A PRINCIPAL OR OWNER OF
- 5 THE FIRM AND IS AVAILABLE TO SUPERVISE ALL PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY
- 6 ACTIVITIES.
- 7 (4) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 2109, A SINGLE
- 8 ACT OF PRACTICING OR OFFERING TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY
- 9 OR USING OR IMPLYING THE USE OF A PROHIBITED TITLE IS A VIOLATION
- 10 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 11 (5) NOTHING IN THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS PROHIBIT-
- 12 ING THE PRACTICE OF ANY OTHER OCCUPATION OR PROFESSION REGULATED
- 13 BY THIS STATE.
- 14 SEC. 2109. (1) THE FOLLOWING ARE EXEMPT FROM LICENSING
- 15 UNDER THIS ARTICLE:
- 16 (A) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WHEN PRACTICING
- 17 PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY ON FEDERALLY-OWNED LANDS.
- 18 (B) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN WHEN PRACTICING
- 19 PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY ON STATE OWNED LANDS.
- 20 (C) AN EMPLOYEE OF A FOREST INDUSTRY WHEN PRACTICING PROFES-
- 21 SIONAL FORESTRY ON LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN AND
- 22 OWNED BY THE INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER.
- 23 (D) AN EMPLOYEE OR SUBCONTRACTOR OF A FORESTER LICENSED
- 24 UNDER THIS ARTICLE WHEN ENGAGED IN PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY ACTIVI-
- 25 TIES UNDER THE DIRECTION AND SUPERVISION OF THAT INDIVIDUAL. THE
- 26 LICENSEE SHALL BE FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR FORESTRY ACTIVITIES
- 27 CARRIED OUT UNDER HIS OR HER SUPERVISION.

- 1 (2) THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT CONSIDERED TO BE ENGAGING IN THE
- 2 PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY:
- 3 (A) A CONTRACTOR OFFERING SERVICES TO HOME OWNERS FOR THE
- 4 CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF INDIVIDUAL TREES AND TREE GROWTH ON THE
- 5 OWNER'S PROPERTY.
- 6 (B) A PROPERTY OWNER OR A PERSON EMPLOYED OR UNDER CONTRACT
- 7 TO A PROPERTY OWNER WHO ENGAGES IN FORESTRY ACTIVITY UNDER THE
- 8 SUPERVISION OF THE OWNER ON THE OWNER'S PROPERTY.
- 9 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN ESTIMATING THE VALUE OF TIMBER
- 10 OR IN PURCHASING TIMBER FOR A FOREST INDUSTRY EMPLOYER, OR IN
- 11 BROKERING THE SALE OF TIMBER BETWEEN FOREST INDUSTRY PURCHASERS,
- 12 PROVIDED THAT NO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ARE RENDERED TO A FOREST-
- 13 LAND OWNER.
- 14 SEC. 2111. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO POSSESSES A VALID REGISTRATION
- 15 ISSUED UNDER THIS ARTICLE ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY
- 16 ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSIDERED LICENSED UNDER
- 17 THIS ARTICLE AND SHALL BE ISSUED A LICENSE UPON THE EXPIRATION OF
- 18 THAT INDIVIDUAL'S REGISTRATION.
- 19 SEC. 2113. THE BOARD MAY PROMULGATE RULES REQUIRING THE
- 20 COMPLETION OF A PROGRAM OF CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AS A
- 21 CONDITION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A LICENSE.
