- 2 WHO CARRIES OR CAUSES to be carried a live animal in or upon a
- 3 vehicle or otherwise without providing a suitable rack, car,
- 4 crate, or cage, in which the animal may stand or lie down during
- 5 transportation, and while awaiting slaughter; -- OR WHO TRANS-
- 6 PORTS AN ANIMAL, OTHER THAN A DOG THAT IS BEING WORKED FOR A
- 7 RANCHING PURPOSE, IN A MOTOR VEHICLE ON A PUBLIC ROADWAY WHILE
- 8 THE DOG IS NOT ENCLOSED WITHIN THE VEHICLE OR PROTECTED BY A CAP
