A bill to amend sections 8 and 62 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled as amended

"Marine safety act,"

being sections 281.1008 and 281.1062 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 72b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 8 and 62 of Act No. 303 of the Public
- 2 Acts of 1967, being sections 281.1008 and 281.1062 of the
- 3 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended and section 72b is added to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 8. As used in this act:
- 6 (a) "Operate" means to navigate or otherwise use a vessel.
- 7 (b) "Slow--no wake speed" means a very slow speed whereby
- 8 the wake or wash created by the vessel would be minimal.

- 1 (c) "High speed boating" means a speed at or above which a
 2 motorboat reaches a planing condition.
- 3 (d) "Regatta", "boat race", "marine parade", "tournament",
- 4 or "exhibition" each mean an organized water event of limited
- 5 duration which is conducted according to a prearranged schedule.
- 6 (e) "Anchored rafts" means all types of nonpowered rafts
- 7 used for recreational purposes which are anchored seasonally on
- 8 waters of this state.
- 9 (f) "Starboard" means right and reference is to the star-
- 10 board side of a vessel or to the right side of the vessel.
- 11 (G) "PERSONAL WATERCRAFT" MEANS A MOTORIZED VESSEL THAT HAS

- 17 (H) -(q)- "Port" means left and reference is to the port

- 11 ANOTHER VESSEL THAT IS TRAVELING AT A SPEED GREATER THAN SLOW--NO
- 12 WAKE SPEED.
