## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 46 of Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of

- Sec. 46. (1) A supplemental member may retire with a sup-
- 5 plemental early retirement allowance provided in section 47 upon
- 6 satisfaction of -each ALL of the following conditions:
- 7 (a) He is age 51 years or older but THE SUPPLEMENTAL
- 8 MEMBER IS less than age 62 years.
- 9 (b) He THE SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER has 25 or more years of

- 1 (c) His THE SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER'S last 3 years of credited 2 service are covered service.
- 3 (d) He THE SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER files a written request for 4 retirement with the retirement board stating the date that he OR 5 SHE wishes to be retired, which shall not be less than 30 days or
- 6 more than 90 days after the date -his THE application is filed.
- 7 (2) A supplemental member may be separated from employment
- 8 in a covered position the first day of the calendar month follow-
- 9 ing the month in which he THE SUPPLEMENTAL MEMBER attains age
