

HOUSE BILL No. 5656

April 3, 1990, Introduced by Rep. Fitzgerald and referred to the Committee on Social Services and Youth.

A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended
"The social welfare act,"
as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.121 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 55d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as
2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.121 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 55d to read as follows:

4 SEC. 55D. IF A PERSON APPLYING FOR GENERAL ASSISTANCE OR
5 AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN UNDER THIS ACT HAS
6 RECEIVED PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FROM ANOTHER STATE, TERRITORY OF THE
7 UNITED STATES, OR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA WITHIN 60 DAYS BEFORE
8 BECOMING ELIGIBLE FOR GENERAL ASSISTANCE OR AID TO FAMILIES WITH
9 DEPENDENT CHILDREN IN THIS STATE, THAT PERSON, IF OTHERWISE

1 ELIGIBLE, SHALL RECEIVE, FOR THE FIRST 6 MONTHS OF ELIGIBILITY,
2 AN AMOUNT OF GENERAL ASSISTANCE OR AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT
3 CHILDREN EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF SIMILAR ASSISTANCE PAID IN THE
4 STATE, TERRITORY OF THE UNITED STATES, OR DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
5 WHERE THE APPLICANT LAST RECEIVED ASSISTANCE.
