## **HOUSE BILL No. 5660**

A bill to require that address numbers on new residential buildings built or used in this state be a certain size.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "residential building" means a
- 2 structure or edifice that is intended, arranged, or designed to
- 3 be used or occupied as a residence by 1 or more persons, and
- 4 includes single family and multiple family dwellings, mobile
- 5 homes or other premanufactured units, rental units, condominiums,
- 6 and cooperatives.
- 7 Sec. 2. A residential building built in this state after
- 8 the effective date of this act, or built outside this state for
- 9 use in this state after the effective date of this act, shall not
- 0 be issued a certificate of use and occupancy pursuant to section
- 1 13 of the state construction code act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1972, being section 125.1513 of the Michigan
