

# HOUSE BILL No. 5660

April 4, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Hoffman, Bartnik, DeMars, Griffin, Law and Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to require that address numbers on new residential buildings built or used in this state be a certain size.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. As used in this act, "residential building" means a  
2 structure or edifice that is intended, arranged, or designed to  
3 be used or occupied as a residence by 1 or more persons, and  
4 includes single family and multiple family dwellings, mobile  
5 homes or other premanufactured units, rental units, condominiums,  
6 and cooperatives.

7       Sec. 2. A residential building built in this state after  
8 the effective date of this act, or built outside this state for  
9 use in this state after the effective date of this act, shall not  
0 be issued a certificate of use and occupancy pursuant to section  
1 13 of the state construction code act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the  
2 Public Acts of 1972, being section 125.1513 of the Michigan

1 Compiled Laws, unless the building has address numbers not less  
2 than 4 inches high.

3       Sec. 3. This act shall take effect upon the expiration of  
4 30 days after the date of its enactment.
