A bill to amend section 9215 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended  
"Public health code,"  
being section 333.9215 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 9215 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1978, being section 333.9215 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 9215. (1) A child is exempt from the requirements of  
5 this part as to a specific immunization for any period of time as  
6 to which a physician certifies IN WRITING that a specific immuni-  
7 zation is or may be detrimental to the child's health or is not  
8 MEDICALLY appropriate.

9 (2) A child is exempt from this part if a parent, guardian,  
10 or person in loco parentis of the child presents a written

1 statement to the administrator of the child's school or operator  
2 of the group program to the effect that the requirements of this  
3 part cannot be met because of religious convictions. ~~or other~~  
4 ~~objection to immunization.~~
