HOUSE BILL No. 5728

May 8, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Jaye, Law, Dunaskiss, Willis Bullard, Runco, Weeks and Camp and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Macomb county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to the charter township of Shelby, for \$1.00,

- 9 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by section | shall pro-
- 10 vide that the property conveyed shall be used for the purpose of
- 11 a public park, and that upon termination of that use, or upon use
- 12 for any other purpose, title to the property shall revert immedi-
- 13 ately to the state, with the state assuming no liability for any
- 14 improvements made by the charter township of Shelby.
- 15 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by section 1 shall be by
- 16 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general, and shall
- 17 reserve to the state all rights to oil, coal, gas, or other mate-
- 18 rials, excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic miner-
- 19 als found on, within, or under the conveyed land.
- Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-

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21 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.

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
