## **HOUSE BILL No. 5826**

May 29, 1990, Introduced by Rep. Dunaskiss and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend sections 1, 2, and 4 of Act No. 189 of the Public Acts of 1966, entitled

"An act to provide procedures for making complaints for, obtaining, executing and returning search warrants; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

being sections 780.651, 780.652, and 780.654 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1, 2, and 4 of Act No. 189 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1966, being sections 780.651, 780.652, and 780.654
- 3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. When an affidavit is made on oath to a magistrate
- 5 authorized to issue warrants in criminal cases and <del>-when-</del> the
- 6 affidavit establishes the grounds for issuing a warrant pursuant
- 7 to this act, the magistrate, if he OR SHE is satisfied that there
- 8 is reasonable or probable cause -therefor FOR THE SEARCH, shall

- I issue a warrant to search the house, building, or other location
- 2 or place where the property, or thing, which is OR INDIVIDUAL
- 3 to be searched for and seized is -situated LOCATED.
- 4 Sec. 2. (1) A warrant may be issued to search for and seize
- 5 any -property or other thing which is either OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (a) Stolen ANY PROPERTY OR OTHER THING THAT IS STOLEN or
- 7 embezzled in violation of any A law of this state.
- 8 (b) Designed ANY PROPERTY OR OTHER THING THAT IS DESIGNED
- 9 and intended for use or which is or has been used as the means
- 10 of IN committing a criminal offense, OR THAT IS BEING USED, OR

- 18 (e) -Contraband ANY PROPERTY OR OTHER THING THAT IS

- 20 (f) The -bodies or persons of human beings LIVING OR
- 21 DECEASED BODY OF AN INDIVIDUAL or of animals ANIMAL, who may
- 22 -be- HAVE BEEN the -victims VICTIM of a criminal offense.
- 23 (q) The object of a search warrant ANY PROPERTY OR OTHER

- 4 (2) If a conflict exists between this act and any other
- 5 search warrant law, this act -shall be deemed IS controlling.
- 6 Sec. 4. A search warrant shall be directed to the sheriff
- 7 or any peace officer, commanding -such THAT SHERIFF OR PEACE
- 8 officer to search the house, building, or other location or
- 9 place, where any property, or other thing, OR INDIVIDUAL for
- 10 which he OR SHE is required to search is believed to be
- 11 concealed. Each warrant shall designate and describe the house,
- 12 -or building, or other location or place to be searched, and the
- 13 property, or thing, OR INDIVIDUAL to be seized. The warrant
- 14 shall also state the grounds, or the probable CAUSE, or rea-
- 15 sonable cause for -its issuance ISSUING THE WARRANT SHALL BE
- 16 STATED IN THE WARRANT, or in lieu thereof OF STATING THE
- 17 GROUNDS, PROBABLE CAUSE, OR REASONABLE CAUSE IN THE WARRANT, a
- 18 copy of the affidavit -may SHALL be attached -thereto TO THE
- 19 WARRANT.
