## **HOUSE BILL No. 5912**

June 21, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Sapniola, Gubow, Bandstra, Saunders, Fitzgerald, Stupak, Law, Niederstadt, Berman, Scott and Leland and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend sections 3, 51, 53, 54, 55, and 57 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended "State license fee act."

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:
