

HOUSE BILL No. 5912

June 21, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Sapniola, Gubow, Bandstra, Saunders, Fitzgerald, Stupak, Law, Niederstadt, Berman, Scott and Leland and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend sections 3, 51, 53, 54, 55, and 57 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended "State license fee act," sections 3, 51, 53, 55, and 57 as amended and section 54 as added by Act No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections 338.2203, 338.2251, 338.2253, 338.2254, 338.2255, and 338.2257 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 4.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 3, 51, 53, 54, 55, and 57 of Act
2 No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1979, sections 3, 51, 53, 55, and
3 57 as amended and section 54 as added by Act No. 461 of the
4 Public Acts of 1988, being sections 338.2203, 338.2251, 338.2253,
5 338.2254, 338.2255, and 338.2257 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
6 are amended and section 4 is added to read as follows:

1 Sec. 3. (1) ~~The~~ SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), THE fees
2 prescribed by this act shall be used only to offset the cost of
3 operating the department.

4 (2) ~~The~~ SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), THE fees collected pur-
5 suant to this act shall be credited to the general fund of the
6 state.

7 (3) SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) DO NOT APPLY TO FEES COLLECTED
8 UNDER SECTIONS 51, 53, 54, 55, 57, 59, 61, 63, 65, 67, 68, 69,
9 71, 73, 74, AND 75. FEES COLLECTED UNDER THE SECTIONS LISTED IN
10 THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CREDITED BY THE STATE TREASURER TO THE
11 HEALTH PROFESSIONS REGULATORY FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (4).

12 (4) THE HEALTH PROFESSIONS REGULATORY FUND IS ESTABLISHED IN
13 THE STATE TREASURY, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE
14 MONEY IN THE FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED ONLY AS PROVIDED IN
15 SUBSECTIONS (5) TO (8).

16 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE
17 HEALTH PROFESSIONS REGULATORY FUND. INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM
18 FUND INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

19 (6) THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE HEALTH PROFESSIONS REGU-
20 LATORY FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE
21 FUND AND SHALL NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND.

22 (7) THE FUND MAY RECEIVE GIFTS AND DEVICES AND OTHER MONEY
23 AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

24 (8) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE THE FUND ONLY TO CARRY OUT ITS
25 POWERS AND DUTIES UNDER ARTICLE 15 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, ACT
26 NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTIONS 333.16101 TO
27 333.18838 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

1 SEC. 4. (1) AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR THE
 2 DEPARTMENT MAY INCREASE THE FEES COLLECTED UNDER SECTIONS 51, 53,
 3 54, 55, 57, 59, 61, 63, 65, 67, 68, 69, 71, 73, 74, AND 75 BY A
 4 PERCENTAGE AMOUNT EQUAL TO NOT MORE THAN THE AVERAGE PERCENTAGE
 5 WAGE AND SALARY INCREASE GRANTED FOR THAT FISCAL YEAR TO CLASSI-
 6 FIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

7 (2) IF THE DEPARTMENT INCREASES FEES UNDER SUBSECTION (1),
 8 THE INCREASE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR THAT FISCAL YEAR. THE
 9 INCREASED FEES SHALL BE USED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS THE BASIS FOR
 10 CALCULATING FEE INCREASES IN SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS.

11 (3) BY AUGUST 1 OF EACH YEAR THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE TO
 12 THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET AND THE
 13 CHAIRPERSONS OF THE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND
 14 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES A COMPLETE SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE COL-
 15 LECTED UNDER THE SECTIONS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (1) FOR THE FOL-
 16 LOWING FISCAL YEAR.
