

HOUSE BILL No. 6094

September 25, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Law, Crandall, Wartner, Muxlow, Randall, Walberg, Pridnia and Nye and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended
"The insurance code of 1956,"
as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 3406f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 3406f to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 3406F. AT THE INSURED'S OPTION, AN INSURER SHALL PRO-
6 VIDE COVERAGE TO THE CHILD OF AN INSURED UNDER THE INSURED'S HOS-
7 PITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL EXPENSE-INCURRED POLICY UNTIL
8 DECEMBER 31 OF THE CALENDAR YEAR IN WHICH THE CHILD BECOMES 25
9 YEARS OF AGE REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THE CHILD IS CONSIDERED

1 A DEPENDENT UNDER SECTION 152 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF
2 1986, 26. U.S.C. 152, IF THE CHILD IS AN UNMARRIED CHILD, BY
3 BIRTH OR ADOPTION, OF THE INSURED AND IS ENROLLED AS A FULL-TIME
4 STUDENT.
