- 5 SEC. 1421. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, A COURT OF
- 6 RECORD SHALL NOT SUPPRESS ANY FILE IN AN ACTION PENDING BEFORE
- 7 THE COURT UNLESS BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET:
- 8 (A) THE SUPREME COURT HAS ADOPTED A RULE OR RULES OF
- 9 STATEWIDE APPLICABILITY FOR THAT COURT, PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN

- 1 COURT RULES OF 1985 OR A SUCCEEDING REVISION OR COMPILATION,
- 2 GOVERNING THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH A FILE MAY BE SUPPRESSED
- 3 AND THE PROCEDURES FOR ITS SUPPRESSION.
- 4 (B) THE COURT COMPLIES WITH THE APPLICABLE RULES DESCRIBED
- 5 IN SUBDIVISION (A).
