

HOUSE BILL No. 6205

November 8, 1990, Introduced by Rep. Stupak and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 1804 of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled
"Occupational code,"
being section 339.1804 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1804 of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts
2 of 1980, being section 339.1804 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1804. (1) An individual, MEMBER OF A CORPORATION, OR
5 MEMBER OF A PARTNERSHIP whose name appears in connection with
6 ~~that~~ THE NAME of a funeral establishment shall be considered as
7 actively engaged in the practice of funeral directing or the
8 practice of mortuary science and shall be the holder of a license
9 for the practice of mortuary science. ~~If a funeral~~
10 ~~establishment is a corporation or partnership, each active member~~

~~1 of the corporation or partnership, together with each individual
2 whose name appears or is used in connection with the name of the
3 corporation or partnership, shall be the holder of a license for
4 the practice of mortuary science.~~

5 (2) ~~This article shall not prevent a funeral establishment
6 from using or continuing to use an otherwise lawful corporate or
7 partnership name after the death or retirement of a member if
8 each active member or employee is properly licensed under this
9 article.~~ UPON THE TRANSFER OF THE OWNERSHIP OF A FUNERAL ESTAB-
10 LISHMENT DUE TO THE DEATH OR RETIREMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHOSE
11 NAME APPEARS IN CONNECTION WITH THE NAME OF A FUNERAL ESTABLISH-
12 MENT, THE INDIVIDUAL'S NAME SHALL NO LONGER BE USED.
