

HOUSE BILL No. 6230

November 8, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Alley, DeMars, Dolan and Kosteva and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 158 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for making reciprocal agreements with adjoining states to cover the taking of fish from inland waters and the Great Lakes that lie on the common boundary; and to provide a penalty for the violation of any such reciprocal agreements,"

being section 300.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 158 of the Public Acts of
2 1949, being section 300.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1. ~~In order to~~ TO provide uniform fishing regula-
5 tions in any river or any of the Great Lakes forming a common
6 boundary with an adjoining state and any inland lake or lakes
7 bisected by such boundary the ~~conservation~~ commission OF
8 CONSERVATION AND RECREATION may enter into a reciprocal agreement

1 with the authorized representatives of any adjoining state to
2 establish the minimum size of fish that may be taken, the number
3 that may be taken in any ~~one~~ 1 day, the seasons when fish may
4 be taken, and the methods by which they may be taken from ~~said~~
5 THOSE waters. Any such agreement shall clearly set forth the
6 waters to be included and the period during which it shall be in
7 effect.

8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
9 all of the following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted
10 into law:
