

HOUSE BILL No. 6235

November 8, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Alley, DeMars, Dolan and Kosteva and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend sections 3 and 10 of Act No. 134 of the Public Acts of 1957, entitled

"An act to establish and regulate the operation of shooting preserves; to provide for the issuing of licenses pertaining thereto and the disposition of the moneys derived therefrom; to provide penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

as amended by Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of 1989, being sections 317.303 and 317.310 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 3 and 10 of Act No. 134 of the Public
2 Acts of 1957, as amended by Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of 1989,
3 being sections 317.303 and 317.310 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
4 are amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 3. (1) Birds that may be hunted under a shooting
6 preserve license shall be limited to artificially propagated wild
7 turkeys and wild turkey hybrids and other artificially propagated

1 species as prescribed by the director. A license holder may
2 propagate and sell the prescribed birds, carcasses, or products,
3 in addition to releasing the birds for hunting purposes, by
4 adhering to all requirements, except breeder's license fee
5 requirements, of Act No. 191 of the Public Acts of 1929, being
6 sections 317.71 to 317.84 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and
7 orders issued or rules promulgated by the commission of ~~natural~~
8 ~~resources~~ CONSERVATION AND RECREATION under authority of that
9 act.

10 (2) Wild turkey or wild turkey hybrids authorized under a
11 license shall have 1 wing pinioned and shall be fenced and
12 released in compliance with regulations established by the
13 department.

14 Sec. 10. (1) The director, subject to the approval of the
15 commission of ~~natural resources~~ CONSERVATION AND RECREATION,
16 may establish an open season for shooting preserves that shall be
17 not less than 120 days, and may promulgate rules governing the
18 administration of this act as the director considers expedient.
19 In addition, the commission ~~of natural resources~~ may issue
20 orders governing the administration of this act as the commission
21 considers expedient.

22 (2) Commission OF CONSERVATION AND RECREATION orders under
23 this act shall be issued according to the procedure provided for
24 in section 8(2) and (3) of the wildlife conservation act, Act
25 No. 256 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 300.258 of the
26 Michigan Compiled Laws.

1 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
2 all of the following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted
3 into law:
