

HOUSE BILL No. 6260

November 13, 1990, Introduced by Rep. Profit and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to require school progress reports to noncustodial parents under certain circumstances.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. Before the expiration of 45 days after the end of
2 each school grading period for a child who is 16 years of age or
3 older and enrolled in school, the custodial parent of the child
4 shall prepare and deliver to the noncustodial parent of the child
5 a written report concerning the child's progress in school if the
6 noncustodial parent is paying support for the child pursuant to a
7 court order.

8 Sec. 2. A written report required under this act shall
9 include both of the following:

10 (a) A summary of how the child is progressing in school,
11 including school disciplinary problems, if any.

1 (b) Copies of all written correspondence from any school
2 attended by the child that were received by the custodial parent
3 regarding either of the following:

4 (i) The child's academic achievement in school.

5 (ii) School disciplinary problems with the child, if any.

6 Sec. 3. A written report required under this act shall be
7 delivered by handing it to the noncustodial parent personally or
8 by mailing it with first-class postage fully prepaid to the non-
9 custodial parent's last known address.
