

SENATE BILL No. 287

April 6, 1989, Introduced by Senators ARTHURHULTZ and GAST
and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations to the department of natural resources; to provide for the acquisition of land; to provide for the development of public recreation facilities; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. There is appropriated for the department of natural
2 resources to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 1989, the sum of \$15,442,244.00 for land
4 acquisition and grants and \$5,147,415.00 for public recreation
5 facility development and grants as provided in section 35 of
6 article IX of the state constitution of 1963 and the Michigan
7 natural resources trust fund act, Act No. 101 of the Public Acts
8 of 1985, being sections 318.501 to 318.516 of the Michigan
9 Compiled Laws, from the following funds:

12 Sec. 3. The department of natural resources shall enter
13 into agreements with local units of government for the purpose of
14 administering the grants identified in section 1. Among other
15 provisions, the agreements shall require that grant recipients
16 agree to dedicate to public recreation uses in perpetuity the
17 lands acquired; to replace lands converted or lost to other than
18 public recreation use; and to convey to the state any mineral
19 interests acquired by the grant recipient with an exception
20 allowed for a share of the mineral interests acquired, which
21 share is based on the portion of the fair market value of the
22 property that was provided by the local cash contribution of the
23 grant recipient. The agreements shall also provide that full
24 payments of grants be made only after proof of acquisition is
25 submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by
26 the department of natural resources.

1 Sec. 4. The department of natural resources shall take
2 steps necessary to make available federal or other funds that may
3 become available for the purpose for which appropriations are
4 made in section 1, and to use any or all of the appropriations to
5 meet matching requirements that are determined to be in the best
6 interest of the state.

7 Sec. 5. Any unobligated balance in any appropriation made
8 in section 1 shall not revert to the fund from which appropriated
9 at the close of the fiscal year, but shall continue until the
10 purpose for which it was appropriated is completed. The unex-
11 pended balance of any appropriation made in section 1 remaining
12 after the purpose for which it was appropriated is completed
13 shall revert to the Michigan natural resources trust fund and be
14 made available for appropriation.

15 Sec. 6. If a person or organization has acquired an option
16 on a parcel of property prior to final determination by the
17 department of natural resources and the Michigan natural
18 resources trust fund board, the property shall not be considered
19 for acquisition unless the department and board can demonstrate
20 that a clear recreational advantage exists in obtaining the
21 parcel of property for the people of the state at a reasonable
22 fair market value.

23 Sec. 7. Consistent with section 4(3) of the Michigan natu-
24 ral resources trust fund act, Act No. 101 of the Public Acts of
25 1985, being section 318.504 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the
26 grants-in-aid to local units of government shall be awarded
27 pursuant to this act.

1 Sec. 8. The appropriation in section 1 (priority no. 5) for
2 various waterways public access sites land acquisition (#88-029)
3 shall not be expended for land acquisition on a lake not specifi-
4 cally identified.
