## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. The title and section 7 of Act No. 166 of the

Public Acts of 1965, being section 408.557 of the Michigan

Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

TITLE

An act to require prevailing wages and fringe benefits on state projects; to establish the requirements and responsibilities of contracting agents and bidders; and to prescribe REMEDIES

AND penalties.

б	AFTER THE DATE OF THE CONVICTION.

(2) A CONTRACTOR THAT IS GUILTY OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT
MAY BE REQUIRED TO PAY TO EACH CONSTRUCTION MECHANIC THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE PREVAILING WAGE IN THE LOCALITY OF THE STATE
PROJECT AND THE ACTUAL WAGES PAID.
