***ADDENDUM TO SENATE FISCAL AGENCY ANALYSIS OF SENATE BILLS 522 AND
807, DATED 3-24-92:***

As passed by the Senate, Senate Bill 522 requires that a municipal ordinance regulating wetland use include a provision allowing a landowner to request a revaluation of property for property tax assessment purposes, if the landowner was denied a use permit under the ordinance. The House Committee on Conservation, Recreation & Environment adopted amendments to Senate Bill 522 specifying that a landowner who was aggrieved by a determination made under these provisions could protest and appeal the determination under the General Property Tax Act.
