A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4009 AS INTRODUCED 1-31-91

The bill would amend the Liquor Control Act to require police to notify parents or guardians upon determining that a minor was in possession of or had consumed an alcoholic beverage. The notice would include mention of the civil fine that applied (the fine varies according to the number of prior offenses), and would have to be made within 48 hours after the determination was made. The notification could be made in person, by telephone, or by first-class mail.
