A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4032 AS INTRODUCED 1-31-91

The bill would amend the School Aid Act to increase aid to school districts that extend the school year beyond 180 days.

Beginning July 1, 1991, a district receiving unencumbered state school aid would have its aid increased by 1/180 for each day of pupil instruction in excess of 180 days, up to a maximum of 210 days. The increased payment would be made in the following fiscal year in the first payment of school aid. As used in the bill, the term "unencumbered state school aid" means formula and categorical aid that is not fixed by contractual arrangement or a specific project grant.
