**CONSECUTIVE SENTENCING**

**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4069 AS INTRODUCED 2-5-91**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to provide for consecutive sentencing of an offender being sentenced for more than one felony. If a person was convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for two or more felonies, whether in the same proceeding or in different proceedings or courts, the court sentencing for the second or subsequent conviction would specify whether the sentence is to run consecutively or concurrently with the immediately preceding conviction. If the court did not specify, sentences would run concurrently.
